

## **Golf course and Spirit Park subjects of debate**

**VANCOUVER/CKNW(AM980)** - More political in-fighting at the Vancouver Park Board over NPA Commissioner Marty Zlotnick's idea that the Musqueam get land from Pacific Spirit Park instead of the UBC Golf Course in their treaty negotiations.

COPE Commissioner Loretta Woodcock says NPA Chair Ian Robertson is refusing to put forth a motion opposing the idea for Monday night's meeting.

She says people are upset, "And so they started to contact Vancouver Park Board Commissioners asking us to find out what is going on and asking for answers here. Why are they doing this is because Marty Zlotnick is an elected official in the City of Vancouver and these people live in Vancouver."

NPA Chair Ian Robertson says he hasn't made a final decision about the motion, "I live a block away from Pacific Spirit Park. Personally, I think the idea is very, very ill conceived. So I am not in support of it but I don't discredit Marty for expressing his opinion."

Robertson says the park is under Metro Vancouver's jurisdiction and if a proposal comes before its Parks Committee, then the Vancouver Park Board will become involved.
