

Vancouver park board release results of on-line poll on UBC golf course

VANCOUVER/CKNW(AM980) - A group headed by park board commissioner Marty Zlotnik that wants to keep the UBC golf course out of a land deal with the Musqueam First Nation says an on-line poll it's conducted shows 72% of metro Vancouver residents favour taking the land out of Pacific Spirit park instead.

While the Angus Reid poll says regionally 72% favour keeping the course out of the deal, it also notes within the city of Vancouver, only 62% of residents favour the trade-off.

Park board commissioner Loretta Woodcock questions how the polling was done.

"What I'm most interested in is I want to see the preamble, I want to see the questions and I want to see the breakdown, I just don't believe it, I do not believe it. It's a farce."

Woodcock says she hasn't received one phone call that comes out on the side of the 'save the course committee' poll.
